EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This deliverable's intention is to explain how the public website of the IT2Rail project is configured and will be used.

This website shall be used as point of reference for people interested in the project (target audience). The public website is important because it will serve as the project's main dissemination tool for people outside of the consortium.

The main functionalities for the public website are the following:

- Information about the project;
- Links with Shift2Rail;
- Information about the partners;
- Information about the consultative bodies;
- Results & publications;
- Providing an external point of contact;
- News & events.

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1. INTRODUCTION

The IT2Rail website (<http://www.it2rail.eu>) is divided in two parts: the public website and the private portal or document repository.

The **public website** aims at showing the main information about the project, the actors and the results to be achieved. On the deliverables section of the website, all public deliverables will be available for download, while all technical deliverables will have at least a publishable executive summary.

The **document repository** aims at storing and sharing project documents, keeping them well organised and available for the beneficiaries. It is a tool which allows following up meetings, work progress and actions at different levels. To enter into the private portal, each beneficiary will be provided with a specific user-name and password. It is their responsibility not to disseminate them.

The web presence will be dynamic and the content will be continuously updated during the project. Beneficiaries have access to the document repository and are responsible for the upload of documents they are in charge of. Work Package leaders have to update the repository with the related documents to a meeting, such as minutes, agendas, presentations, action lists, deliverables, etc. Each document and meeting should be linked to the related Work Package or team/group in order to ensure a correct storage and to facilitate the search of documents and meetings.

Automatic notifications will be sent to the interested beneficiaries whenever events (uploads of new or updated documents, arrangement of meetings, etc.) occur within the document repository.

2. STRUCTURE OF THE PUBLIC WEBSITE

2.1 MENU

The main menu is situated on the top of the public portal:

- Home: main page of the website giving a general introductory overview
- Project: objectives, structure, impacts and links with Shift2Rail
- Partners: list of beneficiaries, including their logos which link to their websites
- Consultative bodies: description of the Expert Groups and the Advisory Board
- Results & publications: public deliverables, summary of non-public deliverables and main achievements of the project
- News & events: information about the project's progress and events related to the project
- Contact: Online forms directly linked with the project coordinator and technical leader
- Private portal: secure area (document repository)

The website will be designed considering the project identity/brand guidelines, in order to promote a coherence image (the EC logo, IT2R logo, other relevant information).

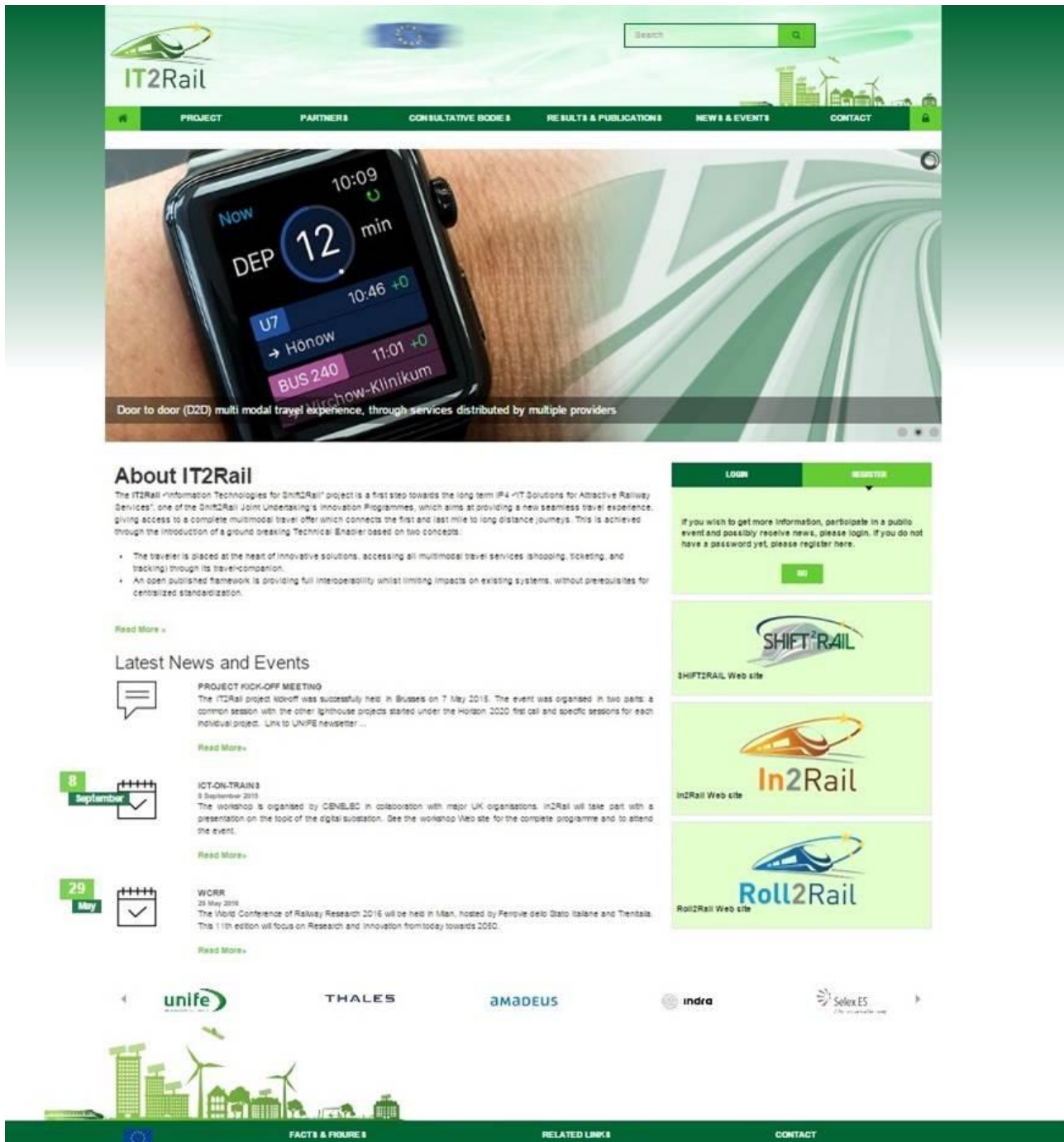


Figure 1: Homepage of IT2Rail public website

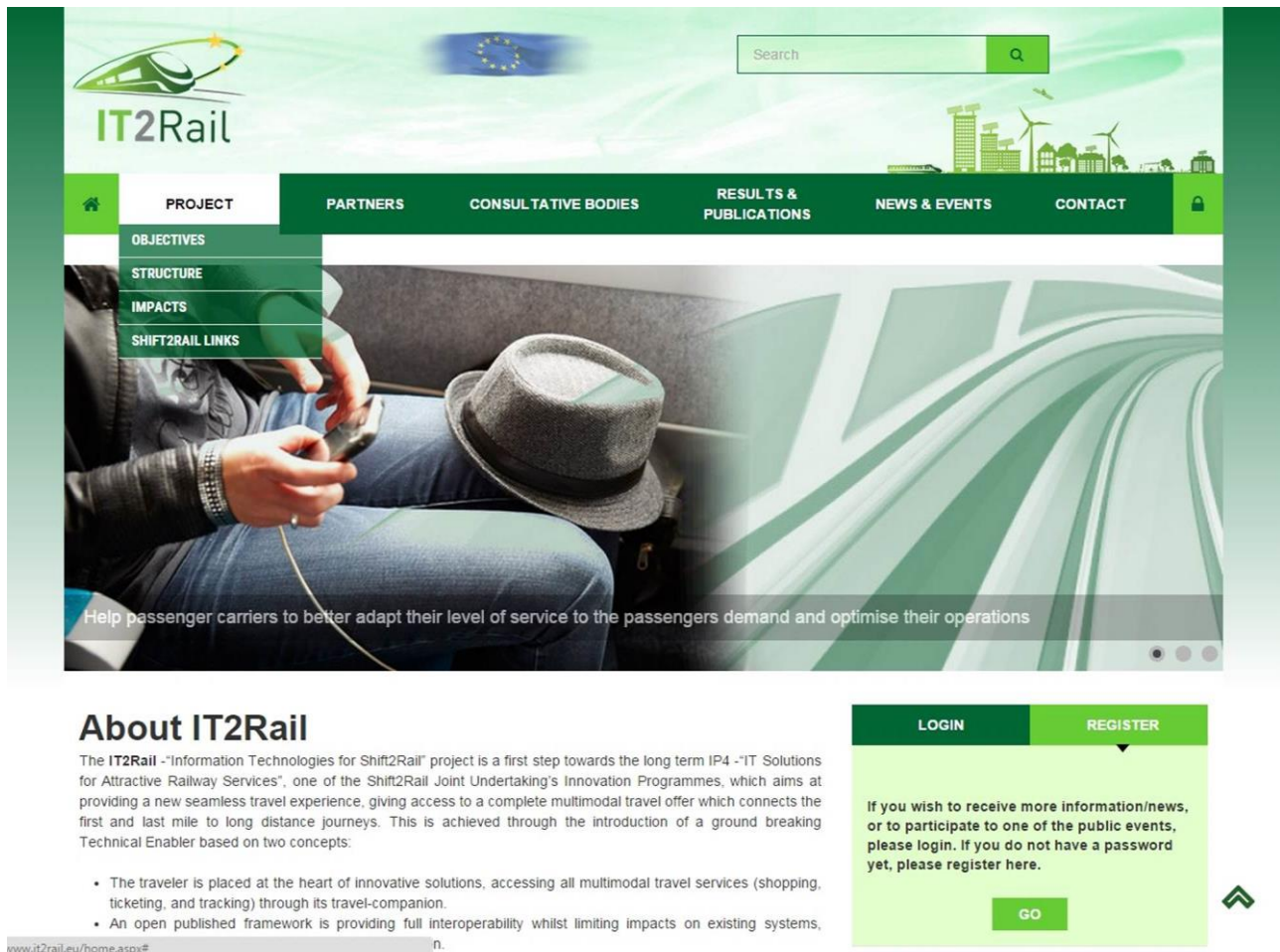



Figure 2: Zoom-in of the homepage showing the different sections
